Veteran DOG (2-1)

What a treat – a veteran!

1 - SHCH CAMBREMER CRAFTSMAN

Classy male of excellent quality, at his ten years still outstanding, melting head and expression, excellent forechest and angulation, deep body, in good coat condition, stands balanced on his tight feet, moves with drive from behind, well hiding his age.

BEST VETERAN IN SHOW

Minor Puppy DOG (1-0)

16 - ZANYS RELISH

A pleasing outline just up to his age, not overdone in any way, lovely head and expression, neck well placed into shoulders, level topline, well angulated, good body proportions, moves freely.

RESERVE BPIS

Puppy DOG (2-0)

19 – MILLROSEGLEN MAKE MY DAY

Excellent head and expression, good pigmentation, well laid-back shoulders, slightly shorter croupe, excellent angulation, in good coat condition, moves very well.

21 – ROCHEBY TOP O' THE MORNING

Nice head and expression, good length of neck, good shoulderlay, well sprung ribs, excellent topline and coat. Tight feet but preferred the movement of the winner.

Junior DOG (4-0)

52 – SEATALLAN XERULA

Classic black of clean outline, not exaggerated in any way, was happy to see a youngster not already fully matured at this age, but with just the right size and body proportions, nice masculine promise-to-come head with sweet expression. Balanced body, excellent topline and angulation. Moved freely on tight feet and with drive from behind.

RESERVE BEST IN SHOW, BEST MALE

42 – BURNTHORN WAYFARER

Male of excellent quality, good length of neck, well laid back shoulders, strong enough topline, in good coat condition, preferred movement of the winner.

19 – MILLROSEGLEN MAKE MY DAY

4 – SHAYMILONEY SENATE

Good quality black, still needs some time to mature, lovely temperament, deep body, excellent topline, well angulated, tail well set and used, not in his best coat today.

Graduate DOG (7-3)

67 – BLACKFYNE RAMBLER TWO

Nice type of good size, masculine head with good eye shape and colour, sweet expression, ears well set, good ribcage, excellent topline, tight feet, moved very well. A happy showman.

59 – DRIFFWOLD HARRIS TWEED

Masculine head with eyes well set, good reach of neck, excellent shoulderlay, topline needs to firm up a little, slightly falling croupe. Good bone and neat feet, which help him to move freely and with drive from behind.

Post Graduate DOG (6-2)

54 – SEATALLAN WALNUT

Sweet head and expression, of medium size with good bone, excellent reach of neck, level topline, tail well set, excellent angulation and feet, in good coat condition, a happy mover.

68 – FOXRUSH ROGER

A typey male of excellent quality, of good size and bone, excellent angulation, stands well on his tight feet, not in his best coat condition today.

Limit DOG (2-0)

5 – CAMBREMER SILVERSTONE

Nicely constructed yellow male of good quality, good size and bone. Masculine head with excellent pigmentation, neck well placed into shoulders, excellent topline which flows down to tail, a sound mover.

10 – LINDALL JUST DO IT AT TIPIBEAR

Well made male of good size and bone, nice head and expression, excellent topline and tailset, a slightly short upper arm reflects in a bit wide front movement when coming. Good turn of stifle, neat feet. Not in his best coat today.

Veteran BITCH (2-0)

What a treat – veterans again!

29 – LAKEMEADOW LADY JANE WHISTLETYNE

Lovely young veteran of good construction. Balanced head with kind expression, well angulated front and rear with correct length of rib and loin. Nicely boned with tight feet, which carried her around with ease. She will do some more in this class!

48 – WYNFAUL CATALINA

A delightful black of excellent breed type, just celebrated her 13th birthday. Head of excellent proportions, neck of good length, good shoulder placement. Topline starting to reflect the age, nice otter tail in function when moving. A good life at her handler has put some weight on her ribs and it affected slightly the movement. Nevertheless the quality is still there!

Minor Puppy BITCH (4-1)

25 – KOOL KOMPANY MARDAS

Just six months old girl of good body proportions. Head just the right size for the age, good length of neck, excellent ribcage with well sprung ribs. Well made in front and rear. Covered the ground well when moving.

BEST PUPPY IN SHOW

47 – WYNFAUL THANKS A MILLION

Good size and bone, clean neck, well placed shoulders, good topline when settled down. Head not really my type, but feminine and gentle expression. Moved happily with enough drive from behind.

Puppy BITCH (2-1)

13 – COOPANBAR CUPCAKE HEAVEN

Black bitch of good size, would prefer more substance overall. Head up to her body, clean neck, good shoulder placement and topline, bone round and feet tight, moved with enough drive from behind. Missed a good double coat.

Junior BITCH (10-2)

A very tough class with many quality bitches!

11 – FOXRUSH LIMITED EDITION

A 12 months old yellow that caught my eye. A balanced body of good proportions, feminine head with melting expression. Excellent reach of neck which flows into very good front construction and good layback of shoulder. Short coupled body, good bone and well let down hocks. She would look even better with a bit less weight. Excellent coat condition. Moved soundly and with drive from behind.

BEST IN SHOW

8 – SHAYMILONEY STORMIN NORMA

Stunning black of excellent quality, sweet head and expression, ears well set. Long enough neck well placed into shoulders, excellent topline and tailset. Good bone and neat feet. She moved with ease and covered the ground well. It was a very close decision.

Yearling BITCH (4-0)

55- BARNAGROW ALTISIDORA

A black bitch of high quality, lovely outline. Excellent head with good ear set, Clean neck well placed into shoulders, firm topline ends with a well set tail. Good bone and tight feet, moves with ease.

66 – BLACKFYNE SUNLIGHT

Good size and proportions, clean neck, well ribbed, short coupled with strong bone. Showed in good coat condition. Moved with drive from behind.

Beginners BITCH (3-2)

40 – AFINMORE ADAIR

Nice outline and body proportions, head not quite my type, but excellent length of neck, well laid back shoulders, excellent topline and tailset. Good angulation and tight feet. Moved well, not in her best coat on the day of the show.

Novice BITCH (8-3)

A class with many very good bitches, some tough decisions!

8 – SHAYMILONEY STORMIN NORMA

49 – RICHBOURNE SILVER DOLLAR ON WYNFAUL

Lovely yellow, liked her overall balance. Excellent reach of neck leading into well placed shoulders. Well expressed forechest and correct angulation front and rear. Good bone, moved easily and with drive from behind. Not as happy in the ring as the winner.

Graduate BITCH (12 – 2)

8 – SHAYMILONEY STORMIN NORMA

57 – GULSARY GALATEA

A typey yellow of good size and bone, clean neck well placed into shoulders, excellent front angulation, hocks well let down, moved soundly.

Post Graduate BITCH (3-0)

51 – SEATALLAN WATERLILY

Medium sized and boned bitch of good proportions, sweet head and expression, clean neck, good shoulder placement. Short coupled, with a good topline and tailset. Covered the ground with ease, straight when coming and going.

44 – BURNTHORN ECLIPSE

Not exaggerated in any way, of good size and bone, firm topline flows into tailset. Well sprung ribs, correct angulation and good coat condition. Preferred the movement of the class winner.

Limit BITCH (3-0)

22 –LAKEMEADOWLOTUS BLOSSOM OF KARELDIS

Nice type of good quality, excellent shoulder lay, well sprung ribs, good angulation front and rear, tight feet, moved very well. Shown in good coat condition.

50 – CRICKLECREEK CAROLINA AT WYNFAUL

Slightly shorter black of medium size, good length of neck, good topline, slightly short croupe, hence the tailset a bit higher, good bone and neat feet. Would prefer a bit more drive from behind.

Open BITCH (5-0)

Another enjoyable class!

12 – FOXRUSH REMEMBER THE TIME

Same type as my junior winner, lovely head. Clean neck is well placed into shoulders, she is strong in topline and her tail comes nicely off her back. Excellent angulation and well shaped feet. Shown in excellent coat condition.

7 – FOULBY QUEENSTOWN AT CAMBREMER

High quality bitch with good body proportions. Head well chiseled, neck just the right length is well placed into shoulders. Well angulated with good turn of stifle. Moved with ease, but slightly less weight would make her move with more energy.

Special open BITCH

32 – AFINMORE ALEXANDROVA

A full matured bitch of good breed type, well shaped head with sweet expression, shoulders well laid back, good topline. Ribcage well developed, well made front and rear. She waved some of her coat goodbye together with the puppies.
