As we endeavour to offer members varied events (and non-members - places permitting); we are pleased to advise we will be repeating the very popular J Regs Seminar/Exam for Retrievers, on Sunday May 12th 2019 at Bowburn Community Centre, Co. Durham DH6 5AT.

The seminar will be presented by
Kennel Club Approved Presenter, Mrs Heather Bradley
and will incorporate the F.T. Panel Judge examination (although this is not compulsory).

The object of the programme, which is most relevant to Field Trial Judges seeking promotion to the B or A panels; is to **provide an opportunity for Field Trial Judges, officials or competitors to gain familiarity and proper understanding of the Kennel Club Ltd., 'J' Field Trial Regulations.**

We anticipate interest will be high and we have **24 places available which will be offered initially and preferentially to members of Northumberland and Durham L.R.C. and will be on a first come basis.** Programme details of the day are shown below.

Examination: This will consist of multiple choice questions set by the Kennel Club Ltd. The questions test knowledge of the Kennel Club J Regulations for Field Trials applying to Retrievers. **You may choose not to take the test. A pass is required before anyone can be promoted to the A or B panels of Kennel Club Official Field Trial Judges.** Should you take the test and fail; you can retake it on another occasion. From 1 January 2010 it is mandatory for all aspiring judges i.e. those hoping to go from Non Panel to B or from B Panel to A to have passed the exam.
